CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

All competitors must register with Golf Canada prior to the start of the Championship. Players that do not register may be subject to DISQUALIFICATION.

OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUND

All players are entitled to a practice round at Red Deer Golf & Country Club on Monday, July 22nd, 2019. Please **email Head Professional, Dean Manz at dean@rdgcc.ca** to book a practice round. Practice round bookings to begin May 24th. Tee times should be scheduled no later than 1:00 p.m. Additional practice rounds may be available in the weeks preceding the championship at the discretion of the host club and requests **must** be emailed to **Head Professional, Dean Manz at dean@rdgcc.ca**.

PROVINCIAL TEAM PHOTOGRAPHS

Official Provincial Team photos will be taken promptly at 5:30 p.m. Monday, July 22nd prior to the player meeting and reception.

PLAYER RECEPTION

All competitors are invited to the Player Reception at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, July 22nd at Red Deer Golf & Country Club. There will **NOT** be a mandatory player meeting but there will be an opportunity to ask the Golf Canada Rules Chair questions related to the championship. Dress for the reception is golf attire.

STARTING TIMES

Starting times for the first and second rounds will be made available at registration and in the Golf Shop on Monday, July 22nd at 11:00 a.m. Third and final round starting times will be available in the evening preceding play at approximately 8:30 p.m. online at www.golfcanada.ca/competitions, in the Golf Shop, and after 9:00 p.m. at the host hotel.

PLAYER HOUSING

PLAYER SHUTTLES

A shuttle service will be available between the host hotel and the golf course throughout the championship. Shuttles will be departing each location every 30 minutes.

CADDIES

Caddies will be available to participants on a first-come, first-serve basis. If you are interested in reserving a caddie, please contact **Dean Manz** at dean@rdgcc.ca. The cost of a caddie is a **minimum** of \$50.00/round. Once a caddie is assigned, the player should make their own scheduling arrangements with their caddie for the championship.

CLUBHOUSE FACILITIES

Red Deer Golf & Country Club will be open daily at 6:00 a.m. There will be complimentary breakfast and lunch for all competitors throughout the championship and a player reception will be held on Monday night at Red Deer Golf & Country Club. Cash and Credit Cards will be accepted at both the Clubhouse and Golf Shop throughout the championship.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice Facilities at Red Deer Golf & Country Club will be available to all tournament players for the duration of the Championship. The practice range will open each day at 6:00 a.m. – balls are complimentary, courtesy of the host club and organizing committee.

LOCKERS & CLUB STORAGE

There will be lockers and storage available at Red Deer Golf & Country Club. Lockers will be available but subject to availability and will be given out on a first come, first serve basis. Keys and information will be given out at registration.

ANTI-DOPING POLICY

Participants at Golf Canada championships must be aware that doping control tests may be conducted by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) on a random basis in accordance with the Canadian Anti-Doping Program. NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

If you find you cannot compete in the championship, you must officially withdraw from the event by contacting Golf Canada's amateur championships department at 1-800-263-0009 ext. 208. Entry fees will not be refunded after the application deadline without a medical certificate. Entry fees will be refunded, less a \$50 administrative fee, if Golf Canada is notified of a player's intention to withdraw prior to the application deadline. If you do not officially withdraw, you may be subject to **DISQUALIFICATION** from future Golf Canada and provincial competitions.
