Golf Canada, in partnership with Golf Ontario and supported by the International Golf Federation, are pleased to invite **CHINESE TAIPEI** to the 2019 World Junior Girls Golf Championship which will be contested **September 22nd – 27th at Angus Glen Golf Club in Markham, Ontario.**

The host organizing committee would like to extend an invitation to three (3) players and one delegate (or Non-Playing Captain). This invitation will include:

- Transportation during the championship week
- Accommodations throughout the championship
- One practice round on Sunday
- Four competition rounds from Tuesday to Friday
- Opening ceremony and reception on Monday
- Complimentary breakfast and lunch during the championship
- Awards ceremony presentation immediately following play on Friday

Note: The Organizing Committee has worked diligently to secure funding for all aspects of the championships since the inaugural championship in 2014. There have been significant enhancements and costs associate with running a world class event and again **in 2019, we will be requiring all countries to pay for their players and coaches airfare in addition to the championship entry fee.**

In 2019, there will once again be an entry fee of \$3000 (CDN) per team which will cover the cost of three players and one delegate. This fee must be paid by **Wednesday, February 6th, 2019** to confirm your country's spot in the sixth edition of the World Junior

Girls Championship. Please fill out the attached agreement form and return to Golf Canada prior to that date.

The championship field will be expanded to include 20 countries consisting of three-player teams of athletes who have not reached their 19th birthday by the last scheduled day of the championship (September 27th, 2019), and who are not currently attending and playing university or college golf. As host country, Canada will field a second team in the competition. The 21-team field will compete over 72 holes for both individual and team honours. Qualifying countries for the 2019 championship will be invited based on their performances at the 2018 World Junior Girls Championship and the 2018 World Amateur in Ireland.

The 2019 World Junior Girls Golf Championship will mark the sixth official playing of this championship – Golf Canada and Golf Ontario are committed to conducting this international competition on an annual basis.

In addition to a 72-hole competition, the championship will include a golf coach's summit and junior girl's golf clinic outside of tournament play in the spirit of providing an interactive junior golf festival around the championship.
