ELIGIBILITY & FORMAT

Competitors: Three (3) junior girls per country (including an additional Canadian team).

This competition is open to female juniors (in accordance with Golf Canada's transgender policy) who have not reached their 19th birthday by the last scheduled day of the championship, September 27, 2019 and who are members in good standing with their respective golf federation and who are not playing university or college golf.

Coaches and Delegates: One (1) coach (or Non-Playing Captain), as determined by participating golf federations.

INVITED COUNTRIES

20 Countries have been identified to participate in the 2019 World Junior Girls Golf Championship based on their finish at the 2018 World Junior Girls Championship and at the 2018 World Amateur Team Championships in Maynooth, Ireland.
