RULES OF GOLF: The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf (effective January 1.

2019) as approved by R&A Rules Limited and in accordance with the Local Rules

approved by the Championship Committee.

The Championship Committee reserves the right to amend the Championship conditions and the decision of the Committee will, in all matters, be final.

RESTRICTION ON 3. (1) List of Conforming Driver Heads: Model Local Rule G-1 is in effect.

EQUIPMENT (2) Groove and Punch Mark Specifications: Model Local Rule G-2 is in effect.

(3) List of Conforming Golf Balls: Model Local Rule G-3 is in effect.

(4) One Ball Rule: Model Local Rule G-4 is in effect.

(5) Distance Measuring Device: Model Local Rule G-5 is in effect.

The starting field will be comprised of 144 competitors exempted by Championship Hosts.

May 7 (Thu) First Round (18-holes stroke play) May 8 (Fri) Second Round (18-holes stroke play)

The 60 lowest scores* and anyone tying for 60th place over the first 36 holes will qualify for the 3rd and the 4th round. *including amateur players.

May 9 (Sat) Third Round (18-holes stroke play) May 10 (Sun) Fourth Round (18-holes stroke play)

In the event of play being either delayed or declared null and void for any round of the Championship, the Championship Committee will make every effort to complete 72 holes by Sunday. If conditions exist which make the completion of 72 holes impossible, the Championship may be shortened to 54 holes or 36 holes at the discretion of the Championship Committee. If not possible to complete 36 holes by Sunday, the Championship will be canceled.

%No replacement of the player(s) who proceed to 3rd and 4th round will be made, even if a player's score is modified under exception to Rule3.3b(3) or a player becomes disqualified or is withdrawn after the players who are proceeding to the 3rd round have been officially announced and thereby the cut line for 60 lowest scores and any tying for 60th place has been changed.

Note: The competitors proceeding for the 3rd round has been officially announced" is when official rank table sheet has been posted on the information board or rank table sheet with cut-line has been posted on JGA website, whichever comes first.

5. **DETERMINATION OF** WINNER

In the event of a tie for the first place after 72 holes(54 or 36 holes, when shortened), there will be a hole by hole play-off over the hole(s) designated by the Championship Committee to decide the winner. If the play-off involves more than 2 players, those other than the winner will be deemed to have tied for 2nd place regardless of their scores in the play-off.

7. ELIGIBILITY:

The competition is deemed to be closed when the Championship trophy has been presented to the winner.

Exemption for the 2019 Asia-Pacific Open Golf Championship Diamond Cup golf will be granted to the golfers who fall under the following categories:

- (3) 2 players from first 10 and anyone tying for 10th place in the 2019 Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship (see Note 1)
- (4) The low amateur in the 2019 Asia-Pacific Open Diamond Cup (see Note 1)
- (5) The low amateur in the 2019 Japan Open Golf Championship (see Note 1)
- (6) Winner of the 2019 Japan Amateur Golf Championship (see Note 1).
- (7) Winner of the 2019 Japan Junior Golf Championship (Boy's Division15-17) (see Note 1).
- (8) Winner of the 2019 Japan Collegiate Golf Championship (see Note 1).
- (9) Winner of the Asia-Pacific Open Diamond Cup (2015-2019)
- (10) First 10 and anyone tying for 10th place in the 2019 Asia-Pacific Open Diamond Cup

- (21) Winners of the Japan Golf Tour Order of Merit the last 5 years (2015-2019).
- (22) Winners of the Japan Golf Tour Championship the last 5 years (2015-2019).
- (23) Winners of the Japan Open Golf Championship the last 5 years (2015-2019).
- (24) Winners of the Japan PGA Championship the last 5 years (2015-2019).
- (25) Winners of the Golf Nippon Series JT Cup in the last 3 years (2017-2019).
- (26) Winners of the JGTO Tour event (2018-2020)
- (27) First 65 in the 2019 Japan Golf Tour Final Money List (including International Majors)
- (28) Players who won 25 Japan Golf Tour Tournaments since the establishment of the Tour in 1973 (Life-Time Exemption).
- (29) Player recommended by the Chairman of JGTO.
- (30) Winner of the 2019 Abema TV Tour (Challenge Tour) Order of Merit.

- (40) 5 players from first 100 and anyone tying for 100th place in the Official World Golf Ranking as of April 13, 2020.
- (41) Special Exemption

If there is a vacancy for (1) ~ (8), it will be filled up in a particular order (firstly by JGTO, then secondly by Asian Tour), which will be repeated until it achieves a quorum. A vacancy in each tour will be filled up by each tour concerned.

Note 1: Competitor under (1) ~ (8) above will be eligible only if he remains amateur in the light of Amateur Status Rules by R&A/USGA.

8. PRIVATE CADDIES: A player may provide his own caddie. If so, he must fill in the predefined blank on application form. Private caddie application must be received by no later than 5:00 P.M (JST) on Monday, April 27, 2020.

Late applications are not acceptable, regardless of the reason.

Change from one private caddie to another private caddie is acceptable at any time provided it is notice d to JGA/each Tour Office without delay.

- Note 1: Players who have completed 72 holes and finished beyond 60th place will equally share ¥2,700,000, maximum ¥540,000 each.
- Note 2: Players who have been eliminated after played first 36 holes and who have proceeded to 3rd round but have not completed 72 holes (including who is disqualified in the 3rd or the 4th round) will equally share ¥2,700,000, maximum ¥45.000 each.
- Note 3: In the event of the Championship being shortened or canceled due to inclement weather or adverse conditions, prize money will be allocated as follows:
 - (1) Completing 54 holes: 75% of total amount of prize money will be allocated to professionals who completed 54 holes.
 - (2) Completing 36 holes: 50% of total amount of prize money will be allocated to professionals who completed 36 holes and finished in first 60 and anyone tying for 60th place.
 - (3) Completing 18 holes (canceled): 25% of total amount of prize money will be allocated equally to professionals who completed 18 holes
 - (4) Not completing 18 holes (canceled): 25% of total amount of prize money will be allocated equally to all professionals who registered at the Championship
- 15. SUBSTITUTIONS AND **ALTERNATES:**

50 spots are secured for each of the Japan Golf Tour and the Asian Tour. If there is any withdrawal, cancellation and/or duplicated eligible competitor on each tour, the spot will be filled by each tour based on the eligibility category stated above, from (11) and (21) respectively. If there is any additional spot available to fill 144 spots after the closing date for entry (5:00 P.M. (JST) Monday, April 27, 2020), they will be allocated to each tour alternatively, based on the eligibility category (11) and (21), beginning with category (21). On-site stand-by will be handled in accordance with the "On-site stand-by policy" stipulated separately.

ROUNDS:

DESIGNATED PRACTICE Practice round is available on Monday, May 4 and on Wednesday, May 6. No practice round is available on Tuesday, May 5 due to Pro-Am Tournament.

20. PRIVACY POLICY:

By entering the Championship, each competitor assigns to the Tournament Hosts the right to use and disclose his personal information contained in "the 2018 Asia-Pacific Open Diamond Cup Entry Form" and "the 2020 Asia-Pacific Open Diamond Cup Competitors Profile", for the purposes provided below.

- (1) To examine his eligibility for the 2020 Asia-Pacific Open Diamond Cup.
- (2) To carry out necessary activities in relation to holding and operating the Championship. This includes, but not limited to, ① sending him documents related to the Championship (e.g. pairings, etc.), ② disclosing his name, date of birth, status whether professional or amateur, affiliation (e.g. club, company, or school and grade), result of the Championship, and other information, to those who involved in the Championship (including the Media).
- (3) To store his personal information and result of the Championship, and to disclose the items listed in (2)-(2) above when necessity arises after the Championship.

21. PORTRAIT RIGHTS:

The Tournament Hosts arrange publicity of the Championship in the Media and by live and recorded radio and television broadcasting and other promotional activities. By entering the Championship, each competitor assigns to the Tournament Hosts the right to make, use, exhibit and reproduce in any way now known or hereafter devised (and to authorize others to do so), motion pictures, still pictures, live taped television, sound recordings and any other reproductions of any description of the competitor made in connection with the Championship (including pre- and post-tournament activities on the Championship site), without compensation for the competitor or the heirs, devisees, executors, administrators or assigns of the competitor. A competitor's name, voice, likeness and biographical material may be used and reproduced in any way now known or hereafter devised by the Tournament Hosts for the purpose of promoting the Championship, without compensation for the competitor or the heirs, devisees, executors, administrators or assigns of the competitor.

22. ADDITIONAL PRIVILEGES Low Amateur

First 5 competitors(*)

Exemption for 2020 Japan Open Golf Championship proper (*)In the event of a tie for 5th place in the 2020 Asia-Pacific Open Diamond Cup, the last qualifying place for 2020 Japan Open Golf Championship will be decided on the basis of best score of the last round. If the tying players have the same score for the last round, Matching Score Cards method is used for the last round (see Official Guide to the Rules of Golf). In case of still tying, please see "on-site information board" notifying how to decide the last qualifying spot after Matching Score Cards. There is no filling up even if first 5 players are exempted otherwise.

Note 1: Entries are subject to rejection at any time (including during the Championship) by the Championship Committee. The Championship Committee deems a player to be an improper entrant if he falls into any of the followings (but not limited to). He is found out to be;

- ① a person who is a gangster member, who has not spent more than 5 years since he disaffiliated it, who is a semi-constitute member of a gangster, who is a member of a gangster relevant company, a corporate extortionist, a blackguard of social activism, an intellectual crime syndicate, or anything similar organization.
- ② a person who, in person or using a third party, conducted/made a violent claim, undue claim beyond legal liability, threatening language or violence behavior with respect to the transactions, tarnishment or business interference by spread of rumor or fraudulent means/power, or anything similar misconduct.

Note 2: Golf shoes that might cause serious damage to the putting green may be prohibited by the Championship Committee.

* In the event of a dispute arising as to the meaning of any provision in the championship conditions above, it shall be interpreted according to the Japanese language edition of the championship conditions.
