Subject - Proposed postponement of the 42nd Queen Sirikit Cup Championship to a New Dates by Singapore

Dear QSC Member Associations,

I am forwarding the letter received today from the President of Singapore Ladies Golf Association, together with her full report on the current situation and the health guidelines required for staging an international golf event in Singapore, the contents of which are self-explanatory.

After my phone discussion with Ms. Lyn Yeo and Mr. Nick Shan, it can be concluded that it is no longer practical or advisable to have the Championship held this coming August as originally planned. All the restrictions and limitations would take away the spirits and the objectives of the Queen Sirikit Cup and discourage member countries from participation under such atmosphere.

With the above in mind, I would like, therefore, to request the member associations to consider accepting our Host Singapore's suggestion that the 42nd Queen Sirikit Cup Championship be postponed again--in view of the health and safety concerns -- to the new dates in March 2022.

Your comment/feedback would be greatly appreciated.

Attached pls find the summarised guidelines for holding the 2021 QSC in Singapore as a Bubble Event.

The actual set up and planning is far more complicated than what's been summarised and incurs a lot of extra expenditure. Furthermore, conditions and requirements are constantly changing so the guidelines may be significantly different come August.

The SLGA and Laguna National are very committed to hosting the QSC but given the challenges and ever changing landscape, we would like to request for a postponement to March 2022. It would be more beneficial to all if we can run a full fledge event and not under Bubble conditions.

We hope to receive the QSC members' support to agree to postpone the tournament to 2022, tentatively scheduled for the week of 14th to 20th March 2022.

This would also assist the associations for the planning of their 2022 tournament calendar.

Please let me have your thoughts on this.
