On behalf of the Singapore Ladies Golf Association, it is with great pleasure that I extend an invitation to your ladies' national teams to participate in the 42<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary Championship of the Queen Sirikit Cup, to be held on 23 to 27 May 2022, at the Laguna National Golf Resort Club.

It has been an extremely challenging and difficult 2 years but we are confident in finally being able to welcome everyone in May to a safe and successful tournament in Singapore. As of 27<sup>th</sup> Feb 2022, 94% of our population has completed the full regimen of vaccination and hospitalisation rates in Singapore due to Covid are at a constant and manageable level. Borders in Singapore are largely open to international visitors and quarantine free travel is offered to most countries.

The event will be not be in a Bubble environment and all visitors who enter Singapore via the VTL (Vaccinated Travel Lane) are not subjected to any movement restrictions once they clear Singapore entry protocol. Currently, all visitors have to show proof of vaccination and a negative test result before arrival. The entry process is quite simple and hassle free. However, due to the fluid situation, we strongly urge all countries to constantly check on travel protocol.
