- (1) National Amateur Champion of (or otherwise selected by) APGC member country whose delegation team finished in the first 10 places for the 2018 Eisenhower Trophy World Amateur Team Championship (see Note1)

We would like the APGC member countries listed above to consider whether or not sending an amateur player under this exemption category this year.

Please be reminded that,

1. quarantine period and accommodation choice/allocation by public health department during that quarantine period depends on your status (i.e. If from designated countries and/or if fully vaccinated *see below link).

*Unless you fall into "no quarantine" category, you are supposed to arrive at Japan on Wednesday 4 May to clear the quarantine period minimum 3 days.

*The cost for the quarantine (hotel, airport transportations, PCR testing) is on you.

2. Irrespective of the country you are from, you must obtain **a short term business visa**.

*Once you confirm the participation, we ask for passport copy etc. and then provide the documents to be requested for your visa application.

*You need to visit Japan Embassy/Consulate in your country as soon as practical.

For the avoidance of doubt, it is not guaranteed that you would be able to obtain a Visa in time for your travel in May.

*We will do our best to be of assistance for visa application as the championship host.

First and foremost, please let me know if you would like to send a player under a continued difficult situation to enter Japan.
