





LLD International Amateur Championship

Laguna National Golf Resort Club Masters Course, 30th May to 1st Jun 2022

The following conditions, together with any additions or amendments as published by the Organizing Committee (OC) at the host club, will apply to this Championship. It is the responsibility of each competitor to ensure that he/she has read and complied with these Terms of Competition.

1. GENERAL

LLD International Amateur Championship (hereinafter known as "Championship") will be played at the Laguna National Golf Resort Club on 30^{th} May to 1^{st} Jun 2022 in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A and with the Local Rules approved by the Organising Committee.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- a. LLD International Amateur Championship is open to female and male amateur golfers
- b. Players must conform in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by The R&A
- c. Players should possess a WHS Handicap index or its equivalent as at 1st Apr 2022 for the respective genders as follows:
- d. WHS Handicap Index of 8.0 or lower for boys
- e. WHS Handicap Index of 12.0 or lower for girls
- f. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to accept and finalize the number of participants to participate in this Championship.

3. SCHEDULE OF PLAY

The schedule of play shall be as follows:

- a. Monday, 30th May 2022 (AM) First Round
- b. Tuesday, 31st May 2022 (AM) Second Round
- c. Wednesday, 1st Jun 2022 (AM) Final Round

4. FORMAT OF PLAY

- a. The Championship will be decided by stroke play over three rounds of 18 holes.
- b. The Champion shall be the player with the lowest gross aggregate score over the three rounds.





5. SIZE OF FIELD

- a. The field will be limited to a maximum of 48 for boys and 48 for girls.
- b. In the event that the entries fall short or exceed the aforesaid respective numbers, the OC reserves the right to amend the eligibility requirements as they deem fit. In general, entries will be based on the entrants with the lowest Handicap Index.

6. ENTRY

- a. The Entry Fee is USD480.00 (overseas players) inclusive of GST & admin fees
- b. The closing date is 12 noon Sunday, 30th April 2022 or when entries are full. There will be no refund after the closing date.

- d. The OC reserves the right to limit, accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason whatsoever. Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the OC.
- e. Official Hotel: **DUSIT THANI LAGUNA SINGAPORE** A special rate has been negotiated for all players for the official hotel which is situated in the Laguna National Golf Resort Club.

Complimentary Airport Transfers will be provided for players staying in the Official Hotel.

Note: For players who do not wish to stay in the Official Hotel, alternative hotel accommodation is available in the Katong area, which is about 20 minutes from the





golf course by car. There are many shops and eateries in the Katong area and Taxis are easily available.

7. DRAW

- a. The draw list for the first round will be made by the OC prior to start of the Championship.
- b. The draw for the second and final rounds will be based on the cumulative gross scores of the preceding rounds.

8. TIME OF STARTING

- a. Players shall start at the time and in the order indicated in the draw. No substitution of players and changes of starting times shall be permitted after the draw has been made.
- b. b. The OC reserves the right to substitute players, change the draws and alter the starting times without giving any reason thereof.

9. WINNERS & PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded:

- a. Boys Open/Junior Division
 - i. The Champion
 - ii. 1st Runner-up
 - iii. 2nd Runner-up
- b. Girls Open/Junior Division
 - i. The Champion
 - ii. 1st Runner-up
 - iii. 2nd Runner-up
- c. Daily Best Gross
 - i. Boys/Girls/Open/Junior divisions
- d. The Junior Division Boys and Girls is Open to players 15 years and under (as of 30th May 2022) and will require a minimum of 8 players in the competition. The Open and Junior Divisions will play from the same tee boxes and all junior competitors are eligible to compete for the Champion Golfer Trophy.

10. SUBMISSION OF SCORECARD

- a. Players should check their cards in the Recording Office and ensure that their scores are correct and be signed by their marker. Any doubtful points should be settled with the OC before returning the scorecard.
- b. A player is deemed to have returned his scorecard once he has left the Recording Office or the demarcated area where it exists.





11. DECISION OF TIES

- a. In the event of a tie or ties for the first place, the Champion shall be decided by hole by hole play-off until a winner emerges. The playoff hole shall be decided by the Tournament Director.
- b. The purpose of the play-off is to decide the winner for the Championship only.
- c. All other ties will be decided by matching of score cards of the 3rd round for the best score of the last 18 holes (1 18), last 9 (10 18), last 6 (13 18), last 3 (16 18) or the final 18th hole. If necessary, the 2nd or 1st round will be used in the same manner to break the tie.

12. INCLEMENT WEATHER

- a. The championship will follow the Inclement Weather procedures of the Club at the time of play and in accordance to the club's procedures for Safe Distancing
- b. In the event that the first round of the tournament cannot be completed, it shall be continued the next day prior to the commencement of the second round.
- c. In the event that the second round of the tournament cannot be completed, it shall be continue the next day prior to the commencement of the third round.
- d. In the event that the second and/or third round cannot be completed, the rounds shall be abandoned. The result of the tournament will then be based on the completed rounds.
- e. However if the Organizing Committee considers that for any reason the course is not in a playable condition or due to unforeseen circumstances that completion of the round is deemed impossible, it may order a temporary suspension of play or declare play null and void and cancel all scores for the round in question. When a round is cancelled, all penalties incurred in that round are cancelled.
- f. The decision of the Organizing Committee will be final.

13. USE OF DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE

a. For this Championship, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distancemeasuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4-3a.

14. CADDIES / BUGGIES

- a. The use of caddies / buggies / motorized trolley in this Championship is prohibited.
- b. All players are to carry their own bags or use their own hand-drawn trolleys

15. INSURANCE

a. All players are required to have appropriate golfing insurance





16. PACE OF PLAY (NOTE TO RULE 5-6)

a. Rule 5.6 (Prompt Pace of Play) will be strictly enforced

17. DISPUTES OR DOUBTS AS TO CORRECT PROCEDURE

- a. If there is a doubt as to the correct procedures, players are to refer to the Tournament Rules Official.
- b. If a Tournament Rules Official is not immediately available, a player (having notified his marker) may elect to play two balls in accordance with Rule 20-1c and obtain a ruling at the conclusion of the round, prior to signing and the return of the score card.
- c. No spectators are to enter into any discussion on a matter under dispute.

18. TOURNAMENT RULES OFFICIALS/REFEREE

a. The Tournament Rules Officials/Referee's decision on all matters pertaining to the Rules of Golf is final.

19. DRESS CODE

- a. Players must be properly attired on the golf course. Blue jeans, designer jeans, round neck T-shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Golf shirts must be worn and shorts must be no shorter than mid- thigh (no jean shorts).
- b. This dress code will be used in conjunction with any additional dress code restrictions of the host club.
- c. A player violating this dress code will not be permitted to start the tournament. A violation of this dress code by a player during the stipulated round must be rectified without undue delay or the player will not be allowed to continue play.
- d. Soft spikes shoes are compulsory.

20. INDEMNITY/LIABILITIES

a. Laguna National Golf Resort Club and the OC of the Championship, appointed officials and staff, will not be responsible for any loss, damage or harm, or any form of injuries that the participants of the Championship may suffer as a result of their participation in this Championship.

21. SAFE MANAGEMENT PLAN

a. All players must comply strictly with Laguna National Golf Resort Club's Safe Management Measures and Protocol

22. AMENDMENTS TO CONDITIONS

a. The OC reserves the right to amend these Championship conditions.
