Dear Chinese Taipei Golf Association,

My name is Kianna Keller, Player Services Coordinator for the American Junior Golf Association (AJGA). Earlier today, the PGA Tour, in partnership with the AJGA, announced that the 2022 Junior Presidents Cup will take place September 18-20, 2022, at Myers Park Country Club, in Charlotte, North Carolina. The Junior Presidents Cup will precede the 2022 Presidents Cup, which will be contested at nearby Quail Hollow Club later that week.

Teams will consist of the top 24 junior boys from the United States and around the world, excluding Europe, split up into teams of 12. Participants for both teams must be at least 12 years old by the start of the tournament and must have not reached their 19th birthday or have yet graduated high school as of January 1, 2022*.

Additionally, participants must be amateurs who have not yet started college and are not members of a competitive collegiate golf program in order to be eligible to play in the Junior Presidents Cup.

*Players graduating in the final four months (Sept. – Dec.) of the year will be considered part of the following year's graduating class.

International Team Selection / Eligibility Criteria

On August 19, 2022, the leading 10 qualified players based on the World Amateur Golf Ranking[™] (WAGR[™]) will be selected along with the 11th player, who will be selected by the International Team Captain.

- The 12th and final spot will be awarded to the leading player on the WAGR™ list as of September 8, 2022, who is not otherwise qualified.
- In the event of a tie, the selection will be decided by the individual ranked highest on the most recent previous World Amateur Golf Ranking[™] (WAGR[™]) revision.
- Each International Team participant must be a citizen of an eligible international Presidents Cup country (excludes European Ryder Cup countries).
- To be eligible to appear on the International Team standings, players MUST have their birthdate on file with WAGR[™]. Once a WAGR[™] Ranking is established, submit the WAGR[™] Player Submission Form.

Starting in May 2022, International Standings will be available and updated weekly at PresidentsCup.com.

A recap story and video of the 2019 Junior Presidents Cup, held at The Royal Melbourne Golf Club, can be found here. The 2022 event looks to continue the momentum built in 2017 and 2019 to showcase the global reach of junior golf!
