

To the Chinese Taipei Golf Association,

Golf Canada will be celebrating the 118th playing of the Canadian Men's Amateur Championship, presented by BDO and the 109th playing of the Canadian Women's Amateur Championship, presented by BDO in 2023. As part of our commitment to strengthen the field at these championships, we are pleased to offer the Chinese Taipei Golf Association two exemptions for both national championships to elite competitors in your country. Players selected for exemptions into the respective championships must be ranked within the top 250 on WAGR. Additional exemptions may be requested for both championships.

The 118th Canadian Men's Amateur Championship will be conducted at The Pulpit Club (Pulpit and Paintbrush Course) in Caledon, Ontario from August 5th-10th. The Champion will receive an exemption into the 2024 RBC Canadian Open (a PGA TOUR event) and the 2023 U.S. Amateur Championship, as well as the U.S. Junior, U.S. Mid-Amateur and U.S. Senior Amateur Championships, if applicable.

The 109th Canadian Women's Amateur Championship, presented by BDO will be conducted at Ashburn Golf Club in Halifax, Nova Scotia from July 31st – August 4th. The Champion will receive an exemption into the 2023 Canadian Pacific Women's Open and the 2023 U.S. Women's Amateur Championship, as well as the U.S. Girls' Junior, U.S. Women's Mid-Amateur and U.S. Senior Women's Amateur Championships, if applicable.

Both championships feature a purse of \$8000 CAD with the champion winning \$1200 CAD for their victory. Player housing will be available by request and ground transportation, utilizing courtesy shuttles, will be provided throughout your players' stay at both championships. In addition, complimentary breakfast and lunch will be served in the clubhouse daily during tournament week.
