#### WELCOME

Dear participating countries,

We are looking forward to hosting you and your players at this year's World Junior Girls Golf Championship that is being held from October  $2^{nd} - 7^{th}$  at Brampton Golf Club in Brampton, ON.

Below you will find some information below that will be important to remember and also information that we require you to submit as we get closer to the championship start date.

#### FLIGHT DETAILS COMING INTO TORONTO PEARSON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (YYZ)

The local international airport, Toronto Pearson International Airport (YYZ) will be the airport to book your teams flights through.

The World Junior Girls Golf Championship (WJGGC) Player Services Committee will be greeting each of your teams at the airport on either **Saturday**, **September 30<sup>th</sup> or Sunday**, **October 1<sup>st</sup>**.

Once the Player Services Committee receives the teams through customs, they will direct you the team to your rental vehicle for the week through AVIS. This will be your team vehicle for the week to get to and from the golf course, and also to explore the Greater Toronto Area as well during your stay.

#### **HOST HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS**

This year's host hotel will be the Hilton Garden Inn Toronto/Mississauga.

The official tournament block begins on **October 2<sup>nd</sup>.** Any reservations that are required before this date, please communicate these requests to Assistant Tournament Director, Sam Brown at <u>sbrown@golfcanada.ca</u>.

The Host Organizing Committee will be responsible for booking your accommodations and reservations for the championship. A reminder that the Host Organizing Committee will cover three (3) total rooms per team (two (2) for players – one single and one double occupancy; and one (1) for a coach/manager – single occupancy).
