CONDITIONS

1. **Organizer** – Asia Pacific Junior Golf Association Organizing Committee
2. **Venue and Dates** – Brookwater Golf club, Tournament Drive, Brookwater, Queensland. Practice round 7th January, tournament dates 8th to 10th January
3. **Eligibility** – The tournament is open to all junior golfers who are under the age of 18 as at the 1st January, 2013. Players eligible may have a handicap that will not exceed 9.4 for boys and 14.4 for girls at the time of entry. Players with higher handicaps may be considered depending on tournament entries.
4. **Size of the field** - The Tournament field is restricted to 120 players with the split up of age groups to be determined by the Organizing committee. Should entries be received in excess of 120 players, non-exempt players with higher handicaps will be balloted out and their entry fee refunded.
5. **Manner of play** – 54 holes stroke play competition
6. **Draw and starting times** – A draw for each days play will be published on the Hills Educational Foundation website. The draw for the 2nd and 3rd rounds will be an automatic draw determined on the scores returned from previous rounds.
7. **Tees** – Determined by the Organising Committee
8. **Awards** –. The overall winner and runner-up prize awarded in boys and girls divisions. Other prizes will be awarded as determined by the organizing committee and will include a boys and girls under 15 years division. The overall winners of boys and girls in combined under 18 and under 15 divisions will be provided with an all expense paid tour to the three events played in Korea, Taiwan and China in July, 2013. This includes airfares, accommodation and meals during each event
9. **Ties** – Tie for the overall winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off. All minor placings shall be decided based on a count back system
10. **Official practice round** – players are entitled to one free practice round on the 7th January. Tee times **must** be reserved in advance.
11. **Corporate Sponsor competition** – **The top 10 ranked players may be required to play and must make themselves available to play in this competition scheduled for Monday 7th January.**
12. **Entries** - close on Monday 31st December, 2012. Entry fee of AUD\$160 (inc.GST) must accompany Entry Form.
13. **The Rules of Golf** – The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of golf approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and with the Local Rules of the Brookwater Golf Club approved by the Organizing Committee. Disputes, if any, will be settled by the Organizing Committee, and a decision made by the Organizing Committee will be final.
14. **Dress regulations** – It is a requirement of this tournament that all players must comply with the dress standards of the Brookwater Golf Club.
15. **Golf Balls** – The ball the player plays must be named on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A. **Penalty for breach of condition : Disqualification**
16. **Time of starting** – Player must report to the Starter office 30 minutes prior to his/her starting time and should arrive at the starting point 10 minutes before their hitting time.
17. **Use of motorized vehicles** – During any round of the tournament, competitors may not travel in or on any motorized vehicle unless authorized by the Committee. Penalty of 2 strokes at each hole where there was a breach with a maximum of 4 strokes per round.
18. **Spectators (Gallery)** – Spectators are forbidden to give advice to a player during a stipulated round of the tournament. Spectators must seek permission from the Committee to use motorized carts
19. **Suspension of Play** – When play is suspended by the Committee, if the players in a group are between the play of two holes, they must not resume play until the committee has ordered a resumption of play.
20. **Serious breach of etiquette** – the following may be considered as a serious breach of etiquette if
 - (a) Hand phone rings or use of hand phone during a stipulated round
 - (b) Verbal abuse of fellow competitor/official/staff
 - (c) Intentionally offending a fellow competitor
 - (d) Improper behaviors such as swearing or throwing clubs
 - (e) Smoking and consuming alcoholic drinks during a stipulated round
21. **Tournament Delays** - The Organizing Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any reason shorten the contest if necessary.
22. **Measuring devices** – Laser range finders and GPS systems can be used during the tournament.
23. **Publicity** – APJGA arranges publicity before, during and after the tournament. It is a condition of entry that all players assent to references to them and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium (including the internet)
