HONG KONG LADIES CLOSE AMATEUR AND MID AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2016 HONG KONG LADIES OPEN AMATEUR AND MID AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2015 THE HONG KONG GOLF CLUB, NEW COURSE 6 – 8 JANUARY 2016

Conditions

- The Hong Kong Ladies Close Amateur Championship 2016/ Hong Kong Ladies Open Amateur Championship 2015 ("Championship Division") and The Hong Kong Ladies Close Mid Amateur Championship 2016/ Hong Kong Ladies Open Mid Amateur 2015 ("Mid Amateur Divisions") will be decided by stroke play over three rounds which will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal & Ancient Rules Limited and with the Local Rules approved by the Tournament Committee.
- 2) Competitors will play one round on 6 January 2016 and one on 7 January 2016. After 36 holes, the 20 lowest scores and any tying for 20th place in the Ladies Close/ Open Championship, the 10 lowest scores and any tying for 10th place at the Close/ Open Mid Amateur Championship Division I and the 18 lowest scores and any tying for 18th place at the Close/ Open Mid Amateur Division II will qualify for the final 18 holes on 8 January 2016.

Should any player in the Championship Division and Mid Amateur Division I fail to score less than 92 in the first round and is more than 11 strokes behind leader, then the player may be withdrawn from the championship.

Should any player in the Mid Amateur Division II fail to score less than 100 in the first round and is more than 11 strokes behind leading player in the Mid Amateur Division II, then the player may be withdrawn from the championship.

- 3) In the event of a tie for first place in the Championship Division and Mid Amateur Division I, the winner will be decided by a hole by hole play off to take place as soon as practicable. The play off holes will be decided by the Tournament Director.
- 4) All other ties will be decided by a count-back. The winner will be the player having the lowest gross score over the last 18 holes (then the last 9, last 6, last 3, and last hole; then follow by holes 1-9, 4-9, 7-9 and hole 9). If a tie still arises, the scores of the preceding round will be applied in the same way. If a winner is still not determined after the score of the first round is applied, the result will be decided by the toss of a coin
- 5) The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf (2012 2015) are in effect regarding Conforming Driver Heads (see pages 137) and Conforming Golf Balls (see page 138).
- 6) Any driver the player carries must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by the R&A.

It is the responsibility of all players to ensure that their driver is listed on the R&A list of Conforming Driver heads.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to inspect any driver at any time during the tournament.

7) Players and caddies shall walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permitted to ride by the Tournament Committee or a referee.

- 8) 8a. Caddies wearing jeans or sandals will not be allowed on the course
 8b. Caddies may not wear spiked (whether soft or hard) golf shoes; a caddie in breach of this condition will not be allowed on to the putting greens.
 Repeated offence may result in the *disqualification* of the player.
- A player may bring her own caddie provided he or she is not a professional golfer. Players and caddies may use a pull or battery operated trolley.
 Penalty for Breach of Condition: Disqualification.
- 10) During a stipulated round, the use of a mobile phone is regarded as a serious breach of etiquette for which a penalty of disqualification may be imposed.
- 11) The use of a distance measuring device is allowed.
 A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play, the player is in breach of Rule 14-3. *Penalty for Breach of Condition: Disqualification.*
- 12) A copy of the Full Pace of Play conditions will be posted at the Tournament Office and will be available on request.

13) Return of Score Cards

Competitors must ensure that they return their score cards to the tournament office within 15 minutes of completing their round. (*Penalty for breach of condition: Disqualification*)

14) The Tournament Committee may require a player to withdraw from the competition if it is felt that the player does not have a basic understanding of the Rules of Golf which includes etiquette, or the requisite golfing standard.

The Tournament Committee shall be appointed by the Hong Kong Golf Association and shall consist of:

- (a) Hong Kong Golf Association Chairman, Rules (or an authorized deputy)
- (b) Hong Kong Golf Association Chairman, Tournaments (or an authorized deputy)
- (c) The Tournament Director (or an authorized deputy)

For the purposes of Rule 33-7 a quorum shall consist of any two of the above persons. Decisions of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all concerned.

15) Breaches of Discipline

A player commits a breach of discipline if she :

- i) Knowingly fails to comply with the Rules of Golf with an intention of gaining an advantage over another player;
- ii) Knowingly returns a false score.
- iii) Verbally threatens any person during the Championship.
- iv) Uses abusive or profane language during the Championship;
- v) Behaves in a manner detrimental to the good name and reputation of the HKGA;
- vi) Brings the game of golf into disrepute;
- vii) Misses a tee time or withdraws from the Championship before its completion without providing good and sufficient reason.
- viii) Is under the influence of and/or uses drugs prohibited by the WADA anti-doping policy.

The Tournament Committee may in the case of a breach of discipline either disqualify a player from the competition or impose such other penalty or reprimand as it deems appropriate in the circumstances. Please refer to the HKGA Discipline Procedure and Right of Appeal policy on the official HKGA website.

16) Entries will be accepted from female amateur players with the following handicap index under the USGA handicapping system as at the closing date:

HONG KONG LADIES OPEN MID AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP 2015
Division I : USGA Handicap Index of 10.7 or lower
(25 years of age or over on or before 6 January 2016)
Players of Close/ Open Mid Amateur Championship Division I will play off Blue tee (approximately 6,000 yards).

Division II : USGA Handicap Index between 10.8 and 19.1 (25 years of age or over – on or before Wednesday 6 January 2016) Players of Close/ Open Mid Amateur Championship Division II will play off White tee (approximately 5,600 yards).

A player's handicap is her official handicap on the last day of entry.
