






APGC Junior Championship Mitsubishi Corporation Cup 2019

1. Schedule

The APGC Junior Championship 2019 will be held from Wednesday 28 August to Friday 30 August 2019.

Hakone country club was formed in July 1954. The course lies in the middle of Fuji-Hakone-Izu National Park, and on the bottom of a caldera (radius approx. 8km) that is surrounded by the beautiful somma with elevation of approx. 1,000m. The club sits in a very rare location with a grand 360-degree panoramic view of the somma. On the course surrounded by this vast nature, one can enjoy wild local flowers and birds chirping and flying among branches. Wild animals such as squirrels, hares, raccoons and foxes are watching players from a distance. We wish you visit the club and enjoy the nature, while playing a wonderful game

5. Food and Beverage

5.1 All Players and Captains

- Buffet breakfast will be provided by the host at Hakone Country Club. *No breakfast is available at Hakone Yutoa.
- Lunch will be available at Hakone Country Club at their own expenses. * Not covered by the host.
- Buffet dinner will be provided by the host at Hakone Yutoa (except on Tuesday 27 August when welcome dinner will be held)

5.2 NF Executives

- Buffet breakfast will be provided by the host at **Hakone Country Club**. *Breakfast is also available at **Hakone hotel** at their own expenses.
- Lunch will be available at Hakone Country Club or Hakone hotel at their own expenses. * Not covered by the host.
- Dinner is available at **Hakone hotel** at their own expenses. * Not covered by the host.

6. Airport Arrival/Departure and Transfers

Please submit "Airport Transportation Request From" to notify flight information and the number of people arriving for the event.

6.1 Arrival

All Players, Captains, NF Executives that arrive at **Haneda Airport** on Sunday 25 August (and on Monday 26 August) will be met by Japan Golf Association (JGA) staff and provided transportation to the official hotel in Hakone.

*It takes normally 2 hours if traffic is still, however, end of August is high season and traffic jam is well foreseeable.

**It is strongly recommended that they will choose a flight arriving at Haneda Airport in the morning of Sunday 25 August, if at all possible. Otherwise, they are requested to move to Haneda Airport on Sunday by their own arrangement and expenses in order to take a bus from Haneda Airport to Hakone provided by the host.

6.2 Departure

The host will transfer All Players, Captains, NF Executives after the awarding ceremony (16:30-) at Hakone Country Club on Friday 30 August to either;

① Haneda Airport

*Shuttle bus will depart from Hakone Country Club around 18:00. Therefore, those who choose to depart from Haneda Airport on Friday night should be reminded of potential traffic jam on Friday evening back to Tokyo Area.

② Hyatt Regency Tokyo

The host offers discounted room rate (see clause 4.3 above) and will also cover the limousine bus ticket to Haneda Airport on Saturday 31 August.

7. Caddie/Trollev/Golf Cart

Caddies are not permitted during the Championship. Players may carry their own bags or use a pull trolley. Pull trolleys will be provided by Hakone Country Club on a complementary basis. Team captains will be provided a golf cart with a chauffeur* during the practice round and tournament days. *For safety reason, team captains must use a chauffeur and not allowed to drive a golf cart by themselves.

8. Team Registration

Team registration will be at the Registration Desk at Hakone Country Club. All teams are requested to register at their earliest convenience upon arrival. The Registration Desk is open on 26 August (7:00-17:00) and on 27 August (6:00-15:00).

9. Official Practice Round

Practice rounds are available for players on 26 and 27 August (Mon & Tue).

Time sheet will be arranged by the Tournament Committee and posted at official information board at Hakone Country Club.

10. Educational Session

There will be an educational session at 14:00-15:00 on Tuesday 27 August. Players must attend. Topics and instructors will be

decided later.

11. Entry Fee

The entry fee is 200USD per team or 100USD per player. See entry form for detailed procedure for payment.

12. Entry Deadline

Please ensure that entry forms must be fully completed and returned to Japan Golf Association on and before <u>Fri. 18 July 2019</u> **Note:** Preliminary entry notice must be submitted by Fri. 28 June 2019.

13. Driving Range

The driving range opens daily from 6:00 to 17:00 on official practice days and tournament days (exception: closing at 14:00 on Tuesday 27 August and at 12:00 on Friday 30 August). Range balls will be free of charge.

14. Locker Room

Lockers are available for players and officials during the Championship. Request for lockers should be made upon registration and locker key will be provided at that time.

15. Dress Code

Team members, captains, and officials are requested to wear team jacket or attired neatly at the photo session and official function.

16. Captains' Meeting

The meeting will be held at Hakone Country Club on Tuesday 27 August at 13:30.

17. Team Photos

There will be a photo session for teams on Tuesday 27 August at Hakone Shrine before Cocktail Reception/Welcome dinner.

18. Cocktail Reception & Welcome Dinner

Cocktail Reception will be on Tuesday 27 August at 17:45 followed by Welcome Dinner at 18:15 at Yamano Hotel (near Hakone Shrine).

19. Immigration Information

All participants are advised to check with Japanese Embassy/Consulate in their own country if they require a visa for entry into Japan. It is suggested that teams requiring visa support documents should contact Japan Golf Association when submitting entry forms to expedite the process.

20. Insurance

All visitors are advised to take out their own individual travel insurance (medical, accident, repatriation) when travelling to Japan. Public liability insurance at the Championship venue will be covered by the host.

21. Wi-Fi

Complimentary Wi-Fi internet access is available in the Clubhouse and the official hotels in Hakone.

22. Weather

Summer (June to September). Hot and humid. Average Temperature (August in Hakone): 23-30°C

23. Safety

Japan is one of the safest countries in the world, even at night when people can walk alone with confidence. Having said that, to ensure your stay is a pleasant one, always take extra care of your belongings at all times.

24. Language

Vast majority of Japanese people use Japanese in daily life and English is not commonly spoken in Japan. As a visitor, you may encounter problems communicating in English, as most taxi drivers, salespeople, tourism industry employees and police may not have reached competent levels of the English language. However, we are sure that they will do their best to help you in a courtesy manner. It is common to see official sighs and public transport announcements in English.

25. Voltage and Plug

The standard electrical voltage in Japan is 100 volts AC, 50/60Hz (50Hz in Tokyo/Hakone area). All electrical outlets in Japan take two-pronged US-style plug (Type-A). It is recommended that you purchase adaptor (Type-A or multiple device) at electronics store/airport in your country.

26. Mobiles

You can rent local SIM cards or mobile phones when you arrive at Haneda Airport. Prepaid Calling Card and Mobile Data prepaid SIM Card for mobile phones can be purchased at the airport. The IDD code for Japan is +(81).

27. Currency

The legal tender in Japan is Japanese Yen (JPY), which is pegged to the US dollar at a rate of about 110 JPY to 1 USD, although exchange rates may fluctuate slightly. Most often you can exchange your currency for Japanese Yen at any authorized money exchanger. At Haneda Airport, currency exchange counters are open from early morning until late at night. ATMs are widespread and operate 24 hours at convenience stores such as Seven-Eleven stores.
