



OFFICIAL COMPETITION FORMAT

The Spirit International is a 54 hole Four-Ball Stroke Play competition, and will have three concurrent competitions as listed below. Each country will be represented by two amateur men and two amateur women contestants.

OFFICIAL TEAM COMPETITION FORMAT

The primary competition will be the International Team (comprised of both men's and women's teams). The secondary competition will be the men's team and women's team Four-Ball Stroke Play competition.

International Team: The Four-Ball score for both the women's and men's team will be combined after each 18-hole round to compute the International Team score for that round. The International Team with the lowest cumulative score at the conclusion of the competition will be the Gold Medal winner.

Men's Team: Four-Ball Stroke Play

Women's Team: Four-Ball Stroke Play

UNOFFICIAL INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

All competitors will be entered into an unofficial individual competition, where all holes scored under par during the 54-hole competition will be tabulated for the men's individual and women's individual competition. This unofficial competition allows all competitors to play under the Four-Ball stroke play rules and still have a creditable individual competition.

AWARD MEDALS

For all official and unofficial competitions, the top three places will be awarded commemorative medals in gold, silver, and bronze (first, second, and third). A tie for the first place in the International Team competition shall be decided by a hole-by-hole play-off immediately following play. Each team can be represented by all four players in the play-off. However, a team in the playoff must be comprised of at least one representative from both the men's and women's teams. All other ties will receive the respective medal for which they placed.
