On behalf of the Asia-Pacific Golf Confederation and The R&A, we are pleased to confirm that the following players from Chinese Taipei are invited to participate in the seventh edition of the Women's Amateur Asia Pacific (WAAP) which will be played from the 6<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> March 2025 at Hoiana Shores Golf Club, Vietnam.

3. Ping-Hua Hsieh
4. Jie-En Lin (Nomination)
5. Olivia Hung (Nomination)
6. Chia-Yu Hsieh (Nomination)

Please note that the first three players are the top three from Chinese Taipei on the World Amateur Golf Rankings (WAGR) and as such they have received invitations. Your association can also nominate three additional players, but they must have a WAGR ranking. If one or more of your invited players cannot participate in the WAAP then the next highest ranked player should be invited. If this is the case, please contact Ling Wong for the details of the next player/s to be invited.

Please note that only eligible APGC Member Association and R&A Affiliate players listed on the WAGR as of 28<sup>th</sup> November 2024 will be invited. We require confirmation from the players by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December 2024. Please contact Ling Wong if you have any queries about the eligibility of any player.

For the Championship, we will provide flights, accommodation, meals, transfers and various other costs for all players. Any inappropriate behavior of players may cause penalty for the 2026 WAAP.

The winner will receive an invitation to the 2025 AIG Women's British Open at Royal Porthcawl - Scotland (30 July- 3 August 2025), the Chevron Championship at The Club at Carlton Woods, USA (24 -27 April 2025) and The Amundi Evian Championship at the Evian Resort Golf Club, France (10-13 July 2025).

We would appreciate it if you can confirm by 20<sup>th</sup> December 2024 that the players will accept this invitation, and then register your nominated players on our online system by this date. We are requesting that your nominations be received by this date to ensure that flights and accommodation are booked.

Please note that the WAAP on-line registration system must be used for all players, officials and guests attending the championship. As such, please find attached an outline about how to register via this system. It is important to note the following points:

1. You have two options available for registering players:

(1) a designated representative of your Association can register all players, officials and guests centrally; or

(2) each individual can register themselves. To have the players/officials/guests register themselves, your representative must use the on-line registration system to first add their names and then the system will email individual login credentials to each person.

2. Please note that the information you list in the registration system will be used to book flights, accommodation and various other details so please ensure all the information is accurate.

3. We will email log-in details to each National Golf Association early next week. The log-in email will be sent from [WAAP@sportssystem.com](mailto:WAAP@sportssystem.com) so please add this address to your safe senders list. Once you receive this email, you can log in on behalf of your Association by clicking the link provided in the email, and you can re-enter to edit always through this link.

All players will be booked to arrive in Vietnam on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> March and depart on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> March. If you have any special requests or requirements or need additional bookings for officials or guests, please contact Ling directly.

All players will be provided with a room (twin-share basis) at no charge at the official hotel. The rooms will be allocated for the players, and no changes will be permitted without the permission of the WAAP Committee.

The programme for the week of the Championship is as follows:

- Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> March – Arrival of players and officials
- Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> March – 1<sup>st</sup> Official practice round
- Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> March – 2<sup>nd</sup> Official practice round

- Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> March – 1st Round
- Friday 7<sup>th</sup> March – 2nd Round (Cut to top 50 players plus ties)
- Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> March – 3rd Round
- Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> March – Final Round followed by the trophy presentation and closing function at the Hoiana Shores Beach Hotel.
- Monday 10<sup>th</sup> March - Players and officials depart

Please note: Official functions to be confirmed

All players will be required to sign a copy of the Terms for the Championship upon arrival at Player Registration, located at the official hotel.
