## 7. Eligibility & Player Quota

- **Division A (Evergreen):**

Female amateurs born **before April 1966** (60+ years old), handicap 18 & below ; 48 players.

- **Division B (Mid-Amateur):**

Female amateurs born **between April 1966 and April 2001** (25–59 years old), handicap 15 & below; 48 players.

- **Open Championship:**

Female youth players born **before April 2014 and after April 2001** (12–24 years old), handicap 8 & below; 24 players.

**Notes:**

- Players who have previously participated in professional tournaments or hold professional status may NOT register for Division A or B.
- The Organizer reserves the right to adjust the number of players in each division based on the number of entries received. If the number of entries exceeds the allocated quota, acceptance will be determined by lower handicap.
- Final eligibility is determined by the Organizing Committee.

## 8. Handicap Verification

- CTGA Women's Amateur Committee Handicap System
- Paper certificates issued by golf clubs
- USGA or R&A certified handicap documentation

## 9. Tournament Divisions

**Individual Competition:** Division A, B and Open Championship

**Team Competition:** A Division, B Division (2–3 players per team / Each country per team)

- ※ Competitions must register for the individual competition before entering the team competition.  
Entries can be accepted into only one of the above individual divisions
- ※ Each country in each Division is limited to one team. Acceptance will be determined based on the order of registration by eligible players. Once the participant list is confirmed, no changes will be accepted.

Open Championship: **White** tees

Division A & B: **Red** tees

## 10. Rules

- Governed by the R&A Rules of Golf effective as of January 2023 together with any Additional Local Rules by Tournament Committee. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final.
- Conforming Clubs: In making a stroke, a player must use a club that conforms to the requirements in the Equipment Rules (Rule 4.1a(1)). The List of conforming Driver Head, please check:

- Distance-measuring devices with slope-measuring capability are permitted in this competition; however, the slope-measuring function must not be activated. Violations will incur penalties per Rule (Rule 4.3a).
- Official pace of play: Players have 40 seconds to make each stroke. Except:
  1. First player tee off on Par3 Holes.
  2. First player to make a stroke to Green.
  3. First player to putt on Green.The player has extra 10 seconds to make a stroke (Total 50 seconds).  
Violations will incur penalties per Rule 5.6b(3).
- Violations of etiquette or conduct may result in penalties.
- Personal caddies are not permitted.

## 11. Scoring Regulations

### Individual Competition (54-Hole Stroke Play):

- All Division: No cut; The division winners shall be the player with the lowest Gross aggregate score over 3 rounds of 18 holes, in each of their divisions.
- Ties: Compare final-round scores; lower score wins. If still tied, compare hole-by-hole backward from Hole 18 on the score card until a winner is determined.

### Team Competition (36-Hole Stroke Play):

- Division A & B (2-3 players per team)
- Each country is limited to one team in Divisions A and B; All Team Competitions shall compete over the first TWO rounds of play and shall be run concurrently with the individual competitions. The team score calculated based on each day of best scores of two players.
- Ties: If the total gross scores of the two rounds are tied, the scores of the third player in the second round will be compared, with the lower score declared the winner. If the tie still remains, the gross aggregate score after two rounds, the scores of the third player in the second round shall be compared, with the lower score determining the winner. If a tie still remains, the tie shall be decided by a hole-by-hole comparison starting from Hole 18 and proceeding backward until a winner is determined.

Teams without a third player automatically lose the tiebreak.



## 12. Entry Procedures

- Open to all qualified female amateur golfers meeting age and handicap requirements.

Player list announced on **Mar 27, 2026**.
- Participants who cancel after Player list announced or fail to appear for the event without valid reasons or force majeure factors such as severe weather, the entry fee be forfeited.
- Please remit the registration fee prior to entry and submit a copy of the remittance receipt at the time of entry to complete the registration process.
- If an applicant is not accepted after the participant list is announced, the registration fee will be refunded in installments within one month after the conclusion of the event.
- The pairing will be announced on **April 20, 2026**.
- Quotas & Priority:
  1. Players entry online: Applications from eligible players will be processed on a priority basis according to the time the entry form is submitted.
  2. Division A : 48 players / Division B: 48 players / Open Championship: 24 players (Total: 120 players)

## 13. Entry Fees

- **Individual Competition**
  - (1) Division A & B: NTD 15,000 (foreign players USD 500)
  - (2) 60th-TLAGA Members: NTD 13,000
  - (3) Open Championship: NTD 10,000 (foreign players USD 330)

※ **Each country in the Open Division may recommend one player with free registration and complimentary lodging.**
- **Team competition**: NTD 1,200 / person (foreign teams USD 40)
 

※ **No additional Green fees , Caddie fees and Golf Cards are required on the official practice round and competition days.**

※ **Fees are non-refundable in case rounds are cancelled due to weather.**

## 15. Withdrawal & Refund Policy

- Withdrawals must be submitted in writing via email with signature/approval.
- Withdrawal deadline: **April 19, 2026, 17:00.**
- Withdrawals due to major emergencies (funeral leave, traffic accident) must be reported 60 minutes before tee time and supported by documents within three days.
- No refunds after the pairing is published.
- Refunds will be processed minus administrative fees for valid withdrawals submitted on time.
- Late or unqualified withdrawals are **not eligible** for refunds.

## 16. Rights of Amendment

- The Organizing Committee may advance, postpone, or suspend the tournament due to weather conditions.
- The Committee reserves the right to adjust rankings based on the actual number of registrants.
- Matters not covered will be announced separately by the organizers.

## 17. Awards

- Individual: Top three players in Division A & B, and the Open Championship.
- Team: One ranking per three teams in Groups A & B  
(e.g., 1–3 teams = 1 place; 4–6 teams = 2 places, etc.)
- Hole-in-One Award: For the first player who scores a hole-in-one on the designated hole
- Daily Low Gross Award
- Awards banquet: **Apr 23, 2026, 14:00**, at Ambassador Hall, 2F, Linkou Golf Club
- All prizes comply with R&A Amateur Status Rule 3-2 prize limitations.

## 18. Appeals

- For rules explicitly stated and clearly defined, the referee's decision is final and may not be contested.
- Eligibility appeals must be submitted before the tournament begins; all other appeals must be submitted within **one hour** after completing the round.
- If disagreeing with a referee's decision, a player may file an appeal after the round—but must continue play without delay; otherwise, it will be treated as withdrawal.
- Appeals must be signed and submitted with a **NTD 5,000 deposit**. The deposit will be refunded if the appeal is upheld; otherwise forfeited.
- Final decisions rest with the Tournament Jury.
