Additional Notes for Players

1. Each team may appoint one person (in addition to the persons from whom advice may be asked under that Rule) who may give advice to members of that team. Such person must be identified to the Committee before giving advice.

The Committee provides the cart for him. During the round he must not enter the green.

2. Players must not ride on any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorized by the Committee except that they are allowed to take golf buggy from 18th green to 1st teeing ground.
3. In the first and second round, each group has four players and each two players share one caddie. A player should not ask non-serving caddie to provide any services.
4. In the third and fourth round, each group has three players and share one caddie.

5. THE R&A INTRODUCES NEW PACE OF PLAY MEASURES FOR AMATEUR EVENTS :

- (a) The first measure is a change to the definition of “Out of Position”, which will now enable groups that are more than the starting interval behind the group in front to be timed, even if they have not exceeded the allotted time for number of holes completed.
- (b) The second measure is the addition of a new clause, “Random Timing Without Warning When Group Not Out of Position”, for situations where an individual player may be timed without warning, including when a group is not out of position, for playing at an overly slow pace.
