TOURNAMENT RULES AND COMPETITIONS

1. MANAGEMENT

The Saujana Golf & Country Club Tournament Committee (hereinafter referred to as "Tournament Committee") shall be responsible for the running of the Championship. It reserves the right to limit the number of entries and amend the conditions of the Championship if it deems necessary. The decision of the Tournament Committee in all matters relating to the Championship shall be final.

2 ELIGIBILITY

Open to all male amateur golfers whose WHS Handicap indexes are 5.8 and below on the first day of the competition. WHS Handicap Indexes must be valid and current. Competitors without WHS Handicap Indexes are only eligible for the Open Championship Event. The onus of ensuring compliance with the Rules of Amateur Status lies with the competitor.

3. ENTRIES

- a. All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Tournament Committee which reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason.
- b. Each entry, inclusive of payment, must be submitted to reach the Tournament Secretary on or before 1st November 2025. Entries without payment will not be accepted.
- c. All competitors are required to submit a copy of their most recent handicap card from their club or documentation from the World Handicapping System for verification purposes.
- d. Any competitor who cancels after the closing date will not get the entry fee refunded.
- e. Saujana Golf & Country Club and their approved agents reserve the right to use the competitors' names and/or pictures taken during the event for any commercial purposes in the future, without any compensation.

4. EVENTS OF CHAMPIONSHIP

The Tournament will be played on Saujana Golf and Country Club's Palm Course with a Par 72 and length of 7,121 yards.

4.1 Open Championship Event

- a. The Open Championship Event shall be decided by Stroke Play over 3 rounds of 18 holes.
- b. The winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest aggregate Gross Score over 54 holes.
- c. In the event of a tie for the winner, the winner shall be decided by a Sudden-Death event play-off on Hole 18 and repeated, if necessary, until a winner is determined.
- d. Other placings shall be decided on count-back in the following manner :
 - i) Last 18 holes,
 - ii) Last 9 holes of final round (Holes 10 – 18)
 - iii) Last 6 holes of final round (Holes 13 – 18)
 - iv) Last 3 holes of final round (Holes 16 – 18)
 - v) Last hole of the final round (18th hole) and
 - vi) Finally, by lot.

4.2 Open Handicap Event

- a. The Open Handicap Event shall be played in conjunction with the Amateur Championship on Stroke Play over 3 rounds of 18 holes.
- b. The winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest aggregate Nett Score over 54 holes.
- c. In the event of a tie for the winner or any other placings, it shall be decided on count-back in the manner described in 4.1(d) above.

4.3 Nominated Team Event

- a. Two (2) players nominated by each Country's Association will represent a team.
- b. Each Country may register up to a maximum of three (3) teams.
- c. The Competition shall be played in conjunction with the Amateur Championship on combined Gross Scores over 36 holes.
- d. In the event of a tie, the winner shall be decided in the following manner:
 - i) Total combined scores of Round 2.
 - ii) Total combined scores of Last 9 holes of round 2 (Holes 10 - 18).
 - iii) Total combined scores of Last 6 holes of round 2 (Holes 13 - 18).
 - iv) Total combined scores of Last 3 holes of round 2 (Holes 16 - 18).
 - v) Total combined scores of Last hole of round 2 (18th hole) and
 - vi) Finally, by lot.

NOTE : *The Team Event Category shall only take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries participate.*

5. GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- a. The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and the Local Rules of Saujana Golf & Country Club.
- b. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel any round(s) in the event of circumstances which make playing 54 holes impracticable.
- c. No competitor can win more than one (1) prize in the Championship and Handicap Events. Gross Score shall take precedence over Nett score.
- d. Competitors are eligible to win one (1) daily prize per day only but are entitled to win more than one (1) daily prize over 3 rounds. In the event of a tie for the daily prize winner, it shall be decided on count-back in the following manner : Last 9, 6, 3, last hole and by lot.
- e. Competitors shall start at the time laid down by the Committee (Rule 5.3). If the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within 5 minutes after his starting time, the penalty is 2 strokes at the first hole. Otherwise, the penalty for breach of this Rule is DISQUALIFICATION.
- f. All participants are subject to arbitrary revision of their handicaps for the Daily Prizes only.
- g. Caddy allocation will be random.
- h. Undue Delay, Slow Play (Rule 5.6) – The player must play without undue delay and in accordance with the pace of play policy that the Committee have established. Between completion of a hole and playing from the next teeing ground, the player must not unduly delay play.
- i. There shall be a cut-off based on gross scores after 36 holes of play. The field will be reduced to 50 leading competitors plus ties.
- j. Scorecard Submission – Players are to promptly submit their scorecards with signatures of the player and marker as soon as possible, not later than 15 minutes after completion of 18 holes. A player's scorecard is officially returned to the Committee when he has left the scoring office and its demarcated area in the Bunga Raya Room in the Clubhouse. Late submission or failure to submit the scorecard will result in disqualification.

6. RESULTS OF TOURNAMENT – CLOSED

The Tournament shall be deemed to have closed when all the prizes have been presented.

7. PRIZES

The Winner of the Open Championship Event shall be the holder for one year of the Saujana Amateur Championship Challenge Trophy but the trophy shall remain in the custody of Saujana Golf & Country Club.

Prizes will be awarded as follows :

- a. Championship Event : 1st to 15th placings (Gross) over 54 holes
- b. Handicap Event : 1st to 5th placings (Nett) over 54 holes.
- c. Daily Best Gross and Best Nett over 18 holes
- d. Team Event : 1st to 3rd placings over 36 holes

8. ENTRY FEE (inclusive of SST, caddie and buggy fees, on twin-sharing basis)

Malaysian	MYR 580.00

Note : Caddie tips : Recommended at RM50/player per round.

9. CONFORMING CLUBS AND BALLS

- 9.1 List of Conforming Driver Heads : Any driver the player uses to make a stroke must have a club head, identified by model and loft, which is on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by The R&A. Penalty for making a stroke with the club in breach of this Local Rule : Disqualification.
- 9.2 Groove and Punch Mark Specifications : In making a stroke, the player must use clubs that conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Equipment Rules that took effect on 1st January 2010. Penalty for making a stroke with the club in breach of this Local Rule : Disqualification.
- 9.3 List of Conforming Balls – Any ball used in making a stroke must be on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by The R&A.
Penalty for making a stroke with a ball not on the current list in breach of this Local Rule : Disqualification.

Note : List of Conforming Clubs and Balls is regularly updated and available on www.randa.org.

10. TRANSPORTATION

Buggies and caddies will be issued on a sharing basis during tournament days.

Competitors may ride on the buggies at all times.

Note : Caddies are issued on a random basis. Personal caddies are not permitted.

- i) Usage of hand phone during play to the annoyance and distractions of other players.
- ii) Intentionally distracting or offending fellow competitors.
- iii) Verbal abuse of fellow competitors / officials / staff.

Note: Any other ‘breach of etiquette’ not listed above will be dealt with by the Committee on an individual basis.

Penalty for a Serious Breach of Etiquette : DISQUALIFICATION
